



Location, location, locationSydney Harbour YHA

Sydney Harbour YHA provides the most conveniently located budget accommodation from which to explore Sydney's highlights. Staying amongst the heritage buildings and quiet laneways of Sydney's historic heart, The Rocks, guests are be within walking distance of many of Sydney's major attractions.

Within walking distance of Sydney Harbour YHA are

- *Sydney Opera House, Sydney Harbour Bridge and Bridgeclimb*
- *Circular Quay precinct (Sydney Ferries terminal and Railway Station)*
- *Susannah Place Museum and The Rocks Discovery Museum*
- *Museum of Contemporary Art and the Museum of Sydney*
- *Sydney Observatory and National Trust and S.H. Ervin Gallery*
- *Sydney Theatre Company and Sydney Dance Company*
- *Botanic Gardens*

Proximity to icons: The Opera House and Sydney Harbour Bridge are a few minutes walk from the door. Many rooms will feature Opera House views and the roof terrace will provide a commanding view of Sydney Harbour, from the bridge to the Opera House and the CBD – perfect to view the New Year's Eve fireworks.

Proximity to transport: The YHA is 400 metres from the Sydney Ferry terminal, Circular Quay, where you can catch a ferry to Manly Beach, Taronga Zoo, enjoy a Harbour Cruise or for adrenaline junkies a Sydney Harbour jet boat ride! A similar distance is Circular Quay Railway Station with regular services on the City Circle and Airport lines and to Central Station for connections to anywhere in NSW and beyond. An airport shuttle will stop at the front door or Sydney Harbour YHA.

The Rocks: The historic Rocks area is one of Sydney's premier tourist precincts. Visitors can easily explore its collection of heritage buildings, convict history and modern facilities. A visit to the Rocks Discovery Museum or a Rocks Walking Tour from Rocks Square (200 metres) will provide the full story. The Rocks boasts great shopping with a popular Saturday market held in the shadow of the Harbour Bridge. At night, see another side of The Rocks on a spine-chilling Ghost Tour. Numerous hotels, bars and restaurants are to be found throughout The Rocks precinct.

Nearby attractions: The start of the Harbour Bridge walk is 50 metres away and for adventurous travellers keen to get a birds-eye view of Sydney, the award-winning BridgeClimb tour departs 100 metres from the YHA. Within a 10 minute walk of the YHA are many of Sydney's scenic and cultural highlights (see above). Across the road is the King George V Recreation Centre, a popular sports facility.

Sydney Harbour YHA opened in November 2009. It has 106 rooms, including private double and twin rooms, family rooms and multi-share 4 to 6 bed rooms, all featuring an en suite bathroom. Standard rates are from \$42.00pp per night multi share or \$159 per room, per night double/twin with harbour view. YHA members save at least 10%. Book at yha.com.au.
